

FOREST SHUFFLE DRAFT MODE

In this variant, you draft the cards of your starting hand. After that, Forest Shuffle is played according to the usual rules.

During setup, return a certain number of cards to the game box unseen:

	Base game	with expansion
TWO PLAYERS	20	35
THREE PLAYERS	10	20
FOUR PLAYERS	0	5
FIVE PLAYERS	0	0

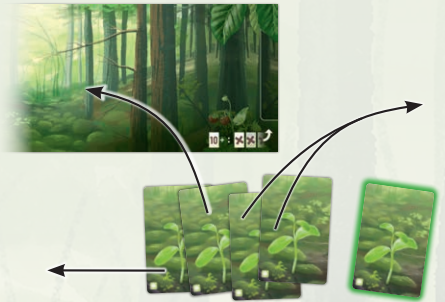


The way you draft depends on the player count. Drafted cards are kept face down. **At the end of the draft**, you first reveal the cards in the clearing and then take the cards in front of you into your hand. If you do not have a tree in your starting hand now, you may not mulligan in this variant.

TWO PLAYERS

Carry out **3 draft rounds** as follows: Draw **5 cards** each and...

- Place 1 card face down in front of you.
- Place 1 card face down in front of the player to your left.
- Place 1 card face down in the clearing.
- Put 2 cards face down back into the game box.



THREE PLAYERS

Carry out **2 draft rounds** as follows: Draw **6 cards** each and...

- Place 1 card face down in front of you.
- Place 1 card each face down in front of the players to your left and right.
- Place 1 card face down in the clearing.
- Put 2 cards face down back into the game box.

FOUR PLAYERS

Carry out **1 draft round** as follows: Draw **9 cards** each and...

- Place 2 cards face down in front of you.
- Place 2 cards each face down in front of the players to your left and right.
- Place 1 card face down in the clearing.
- Put 2 cards face down back into the game box.

FIVE PLAYERS

Carry out **1 draft round** as follows: Draw **7 cards** each and...

- Place 2 cards face down in front of you.
- Place 2 cards each face down in front of the players to your left and right.
- Place 1 card face down in the clearing.
